The National Forestry Program of Turkmenistan serves as the basis for plans for the preparation of regulatory legal acts and research work, organizational measures for the development of forestry in the country, as well as identifying key areas for the development of international cooperation in the forestry industry and its development based on the best world experience.

Road and water infrastructure to be allocated more money from state budget expenditures 28/06/2021

Vozrozhdenie company: a new stage in the construction of mudflow protection 03/07/2021

The branch of the Vozrozhdenie company in Turkmenistan has completed a large volume of basic earthworks on the construction of a complex of mudflow protection structures in the capital and has begun concrete work. He will have to create a system of canals and pipelines (including the device of selenium accumulators, pumping stations, transfer, filtration and head structures), to reconstruct the existing canal, to complete road works and the power supply.

IAEA: Uzbekistan is ready to build its first nuclear power plant 03/07/2021

In June, a group of experts from the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) paid a 12-day visit to Uzbekistan. Inspectors comprehensively assessed the infrastructure development process for the nuclear power program and came to the conclusion that everything is going according to plan and in compliance with all regulatory requirements.

The members of the group stated that "Uzbekistan has made significant progress in developing the nuclear power plant project and has taken steps to improve the regulatory framework and strengthen the capacity of the regulator". They added that the country's nuclear power program enjoys strong government support.
