### **US troops surge evacuations out of Kabul but threats persist 25/08/2021**

WASHINGTON (AP) — The U.S. military pulled off its biggest day of evacuation flights out of Afghanistan by far on Monday, but deadly violence that has blocked many desperate evacuees from entering Kabul's airport persisted, and the Taliban signaled they might soon seek to shut down the airlifts.

Twenty-eight U.S. military flights ferried about 10,400 people to safety out of Taliban-held Afghanistan over 24 hours that ended early Monday morning, and 15 C-17 flights over the next 12 hours brought out another 6,660, White House officials said. The chief Pentagon spokesman, John Kirby, said the faster pace of evacuation was due in part to coordination with Taliban commanders on getting evacuees into the airport.

## **At least 28 Taliban members died in Kabul blasts 27/08/2021**

At least 28 out of 103 people who died in the recent explosion near the Kabul airport were Taliban members, Reuters news agency reported on Friday, citing a Taliban (outlawed in Russia) representative.

"We have lost more people than the Americans," the official said. He also believes there are no reasons to extend the foreign troop withdrawal deadline.

On Thursday, two suicide bombers attacked crowds of people gathered near the Kabul airport. Earlier, reports emerged about 103 deaths, including 13 US military personnel. The Taliban has resolutely condemned the tragedy and vowed to hold those behind it responsible.

### **US forces move into final phase of evacuation from Afghanistan 29/08/2021**

**Bishkek, Aug. 29, 2021. / Kabar /. The US Armed Forces have entered the final phase of the operation to evacuate people from Afghanistan, TASS reported.**

According to the source, by now about 1,000 people are awaiting evacuation by US military transport planes at the Kabul airport. A Reuters source also noted that crowds in front of the gates to the airport began to dissipate after reports of likely new terrorist attacks. The evacuation of civilians is scheduled to be completed on Sunday, the agency was told.
